

Adobe Acrobat Reader Toolbar Help: Display Options



Thumbnail & Page: To display the current page of the open document, click here. A representation of all the pages in the document will appear if thumbnails have been generated. Thumbnails allow you to easily select any page in the document for viewing.



Bookmarks & Page: If bookmarks have been generated, click here to display the current page of the open document as well as an index of topics.



Page: To display only the current page of the open document, click here.

Adobe Acrobat Reader Toolbar Help:

Mouse Options



Text Selection: To select text, click here and drag the cursor over the text that you want. You may then copy and paste this text into other documents.



Zoom-in: Select the magnifying glass to zoom in on an area of the document. Place the magnifying glass over the area you want to zoom in on and click the mouse button. Zoom out by holding down the **ALT** key and clicking the mouse button.



Hand: Select the default mouse cursor to navigate the current page. When the hand changes to a pointing index finger, you have moved over a hot link or an interactive object. You can also scroll up and down the page by clicking the up and down arrows on the side of the window.

Document Viewing Options



Fit Page Width In Window: To zoom in on the document until the page width is equal to that of the window, click here. This will not display the whole page at once, however. You will have to scroll down the view the rest of the page.



Fit Page In Window: To zoom in on the current page until it is as large as it can be while still fitting entirely on the screen, click here.



100% Zoom: To view the current page on screen at its original size, click here.
